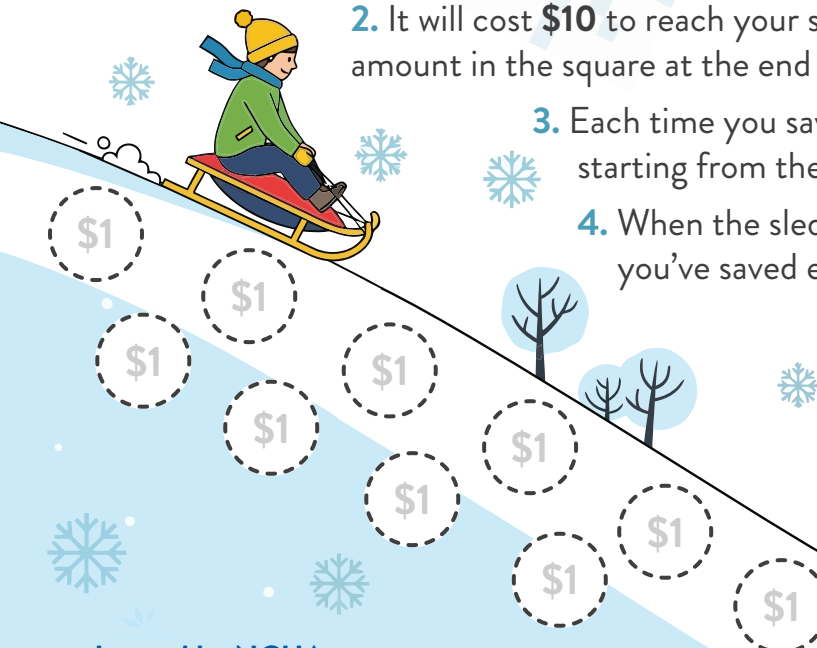


# Sled into Savings
