Green Chores for Green Rewards

Chores help you learn important skills that you'll use for the rest of your life, such as being responsible and taking care of your home. Green chores, like turning out the lights or sorting recycling, also help take care of the Earth.



Chores are also great ways for you to start practicing how to earn money.

When you do a job and earn money or a treat, you're learning that effort leads to rewards. This helps you understand how people earn money as adults. By starting now, you're building strong habits that will help you make good choices, save money, and feel proud of yourself.

Ask an adult to help you review the suggestions below and see if you would like to set up a chore schedule.

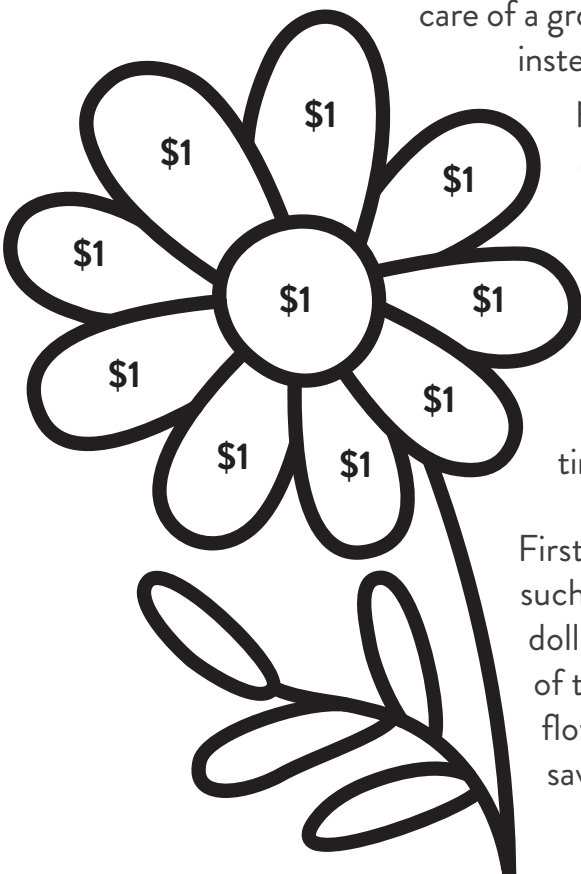
1. Consider what chores might be helpful for your family. You could water plants around your home, sort recycling, turn off the lights, or help in the garden.
2. Create a schedule for what days each week you will complete your chores.
3. Talk to an adult to help determine the reward amount for completed chores.
4. Collect your rewards, count your savings, and watch as your money grows!



Watch Your Savings Grow

You can take care of your money just like you take care of a growing plant. When you save your money instead of spending it right away, you are planning for the future. Your savings are the coins or dollars you choose to keep. When you choose something special you want to save for, that becomes your goal. To reach your goal, you can keep track of how much money you've saved. Just like watching a seed grow into a plant, your savings grow each time you add more money.

First, choose a savings goal worth \$10, such as a toy or book. With each dollar you save, color a section of the flower. When the whole flower is colored, you've reached your savings goal!
