There are several ways to jump-start your savings. We've listed a few below. Talk to your parents before you start any of these ideas to make sure they're okay with your plan.

Open a lemonade stand. Create an eye-catching stand using a card table or other small table and brightly colored signs.

Have a yard sale. Collect all of your unused toys and outgrown clothing and sell them in a yard sale. Be sure to advertise your sale at least one week in advance by putting up attention-grabbing posters throughout your neighborhood or by placing an ad in your local newspaper.

Offer your expertise. Ask your parents, neighbors, or grandparents if they would like to hire you to weed, wash cars, mow yards, or do other chores for them.

Recycle. There are many recycling stations that accept paper, plastic and glass deposits in return for cash. Ask your family and friends for help with collecting the items around their houses and then have your parents help you drop the items off at a recycling station.


