There are many reasons to put your money in your South Carolina Federal Credit Union Kids Club account! Here are some of the really good ones:


- The money you deposit into your Kids Club account will earn dividends (money we pay you for keeping it here), which means your money will add up faster in your account than it would in your piggy bank.
